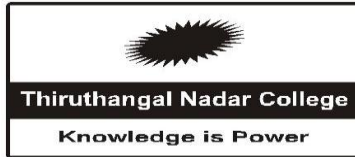

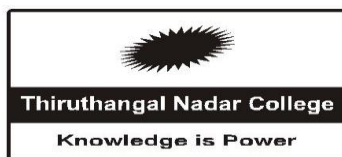

THIRUTHANGAL NADAR COLLEGE

A PROFILE

Thiruthangal, a Municipality in Virudhunagar District is located 68 kilometres south of Madurai, very close to Sivakasi, a town well known for safety matches, fireworks and printing units. On top of a small hill in Thiruthangal, there are three temples one for Lord Shiva and two others for Lord Muruga and Lord Vishnu. Vishnu is known here as Thirunindra Narayana Perumal and the Goddess as Sengamala Nachiar. This Vaishnavite temple, constructed in 994 A.D. by a native of Thiruthangal, who served as an important Minister to the then Pandya King is one among the 108 sacred places of worship for the vaishnavites. The village had once flourished in agriculture. Later on, the scanty rains in the area and the poor returns from agriculture made the people migrate to urban centers to earn their livelihood, by trade and business. At present, due to the proximity of Sivakasi, Thiruthangal has been witnessing a rapid growth of lucrative business-like fireworks, match works, printing and other industries.

Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund was founded in 1920 at Thiruthangal village by a few well-meaning and like-minded elders concerned in the development of the community. Thiruthangal Nadar Bungalow was built on 28th October 1929 by the laudable efforts of Sri. A. Vellaippa Nadar, the President, Sri. Shanmuga Nadar, the Secretary and Sri. V. Hariharaputra Nadar, the Treasurer of Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund. On 9th October 1963 Kalaimagal Primary School was started. Later Girls Higher Secondary School in the name of Sivasubramania Nadar and Guruvammal was started on 21st June 1982. Karuman Karuppanna Nadar Ayyakannammal Matriculation School was founded on 3rd June 1991. More than 6100 students receive quality education and about 216 teachers are employed in these institutions.

Thiruthangal Hindu Nadars, settled in Chennai planned to form an organization for their welfare. They assembled at Backia Bhavanam (located in Tondiarpet, Chennai) of T.A.S. Rathinam & Brothers, on 14th September 1956. Fifty-Two persons attended the meeting and established the Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund (a Charitable Fund of Thiruthangal Hindu Nadars living in Chennai). The First Anniversary was held on 15th September 1957. The said fund was registered in 1961 under the Societies Registration Act.

This organization was established owing to the arduous efforts of Thiru.S. Gurusamy Nadar of Thiruthangal, Thiru. P.S. Thangaiah Nadar of Rajapalayam, Thiru. M.S. Ramaiah Nadar of Tiruchirappalli and Thiru. T.A.S. Arumugam of Chennai. In the early periods of the establishment of the Uravinmurai Fund, Thiru. T.A.S. Chelliah served as President and Thiru. Raja K.S.P. Ganesan served as the Secretary. Thiru. S.M. Gurusamy Nadar, Thiru. "Lathas" K.Thangappa Nadar, Thiru.S.Chinnadurai have collectively rendered yeomen service for the growth of the organization in the initial period of its establishment.

The next milestone was in 1968 when the organization purchased a site in G.A. Road,(Now P.A.N. Rajarathinam Road), Washermenpet, Chennai-21. In the said site, a magnificent building Door No.113, named as Thiruthangal Nadar Arangam an epitome of the members unity and solidarity was constructed with the great efforts of Thiru. M.G.Erulangudi Nadar, Treasurer of the Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund who was fondly addressed as "Elam Hariharaputranar". The Arangam was inaugurated on 23rd May 1983 and the following office bearers were elected during the year 1980-1983.

Another turning point is the establishment of “Thiruthangal Nadar Educational Society” as part of Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund on 20th September 1987. This society was registered under Tamil Nadu Registration Act 1975. The first set of office bearers were Thiru.S.M. Gurusamy Nadar as President, Thiru. R.G.Chandramogan as Secretary, Thiru S.Chandran as Asst. Secretary and Thiru. C.Kaniratham as Treasurer. Thiruthangal Nadar Educational Society was merged with Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund on 3rd May 2007.

Despite its financial constraints, the Educational Society, with its noble idea of service purchased 9.76 acres of land in the Selavayal area of Chennai – 51.

On 3rd August, 1997 the “Thiruthangal Nadar College” for men was started as an Arts and Science College with Dr. A.P. Kamalakara Rao as the founder Principal. The college functions as a Self-Financing Institution without any grant or aid or subsidies from the Government for its maintenance. There is no collection of donation, capitation or other kinds of receipts from the parents. Compared to other self-financing colleges, the college faculty are paid a decent salary. Thiruthangal Nadar College has become a Co-educational Institution from the academic year 2002-2003. Additional facilities are provided for the women students.

The college has been functioning to cater to the needs of a backward area purely with an altruistic ideal of providing higher education at a moderate cost without any discrimination of caste or creed.

At this juncture it would be no exaggeration to state that the committed services of the Executive Committee Members of Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund are in line with the dedication and dynamic leadership of the then Secretary Thiru. S.M. Subbiah whose

efforts complimented and led to the incredible progress of Thiruthangal Nadar College to be engraved in golden letters.

On 30th April 2004 the Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund had purchased 14.5 grounds of land worth about Rs. 1.5 crores at No. 1050, T.H.Road, Chennai-600 019 with a plan to establish a school. The dream came true in the year 2010 as "Thiruthangal Nadar Vidhyalaya". Presently a reputed C.B.S.E. School "Thiruthangal Nadar Vidhyalaya" No.1051, T.H. Road, Thangal, Chennai-19, functions in a full-fledged manner providing a positive learning environment for the student community.

TNC had a humble start with 5 Under Graduate Programs namely B. Com General, B.Com.CS, BBA, B.Sc Mathematics and B.Sc. Computer Science Eventually the college identified the need for new degree programs and this was based on factors such as industry demand, student interest and emerging fields. The College ensures that the new programs align with their mission, goals, and resources to provide a quality educational experience for students. The B.C.A program was introduced in 1999 followed by M.Sc CST (5 year integrated PG Course) in 2001 and B.Com ISM in 2002. The UG programs B.Com (B.M.), B.Com (A/F) and B.Sc. (Software Application), were initiated in the year 2008. The PG Programs M.Sc Computer Science was introduced in the year 2015 and M.Com General in 2016.

In addition, B.Com (Computer Application), was launched in the year 2011 followed by B.Sc. (Physics), B.Sc. (Chemistry) and B.A (English Literature) programs in 2017 Keeping in mind the student's demand, UG Programs B.Com General, B.Sc Mathematics and B.C.A were established in Shift II also in the same year ie 2017 And, B.Com CS was introduced in Shift II in the following year ie 2018 for the same reason.

Further, B.Sc (Plant Biology & Plant Bio-Technology) and B.S.W (Social Work) programs were initiated in the year 2018.

In addition, B.A. (Tamil Literature) and B.A. (Criminology & Police Administration) were started in the year 2019.

B.Sc. Computer Science with Artificial Intelligence and M.S.W were introduced in 2024.

Currently B.Sc.- Computer Science with Data Science has been introduced this year (2025).

For the academic year 2024-2025 the total strength of the students has come up to **2618** students (**1853 Boys and 765 Girls**).

FUNCTIONS

The Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) is a body envisaged to receive complaints on sexual harassment at the workplace from an aggrieved woman, as well as to inquire into and make recommendations to the employer on the action required pursuant to its inquiry of such complaint.

Powers of the Internal Complaint Committee

Sec 11(3) of the POSH Act enumerates the powers of the Internal Complaints Committee. The ICC is vested with the powers of a Civil Court under the Civil Procedure Code, 1908 in the following:

- 1) It is entitled to initiate an inquiry into the complaint of a sexual harassment incident at the workplace
- 2) It can summon witnesses and parties before the committee to give a statement
- 3) It can assert its powers and summon evidence to be examined if it is deemed necessary to do so by the Committee

LIBRARY:

The college has assigned due importance to the library. To maintain and improvise the Physical fitness of the students and Staff members a modern gym is setup with essential equipments and training is provided under the guidance of well-trained professionals. We develop physically active students who tend to have better grace. Cognitive performance and good classroom behaviour.

CAFETERIA

The college has a large spacious canteen separately for boys and girls. Adding to it, a provision for staff members encompassing an area of 7.200 sq.ft. is provided. It provides a variety of hygienic refreshment and nutritious food with customized care at moderate price. Best quality services are offered in a healthy and refreshing atmosphere.

AUDITORIUM

An Indoor Auditorium with a capacity of 1,000 seats and a separate block for U.G. and PG. courses in the first and second floor of the auditorium were constructed. The building is named after S.M Gurusamy Nadar and G. Valliammal and the auditorium stands in the name of M. G. Erulangudi Nadar and E Valliammal.

The present infrastructure is optimally used by the beneficiaries of the college. Perunthalaivar Kamarajar open air auditorium with a marbled floor with EPI coated roofing and an accommodation of 3,000 seating capacity with Front-of-house facility, has been constructed for the students to exhibit their exorbitant skills and to cater to their other academic needs. Substantial investments have been made to augment existing infrastructure

An Air-Conditioned Conference Hall named Thiruthangal Gnaniyar S Arumuga Nadar Meenammal Trust Conference Hall (A/C) holding a seating capacity of 300 and an area of 2,519 sq. ft has been erected to cater to the academic and aesthetic needs of the students and the faculty

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWAL

- ❖ Application for admission to the college is to be made in the prescribed form on or before the last date of submission notified. Admitted students must submit their original transfer certificate, statement of marks, and other certificates from the school or college last studied at the time of admission.
- ❖ The Applicants will be enrolled and permitted to attend the classes only after the payment of the tuition fees on or before the specified date.
- ❖ The second- and third-year students should pay their fees within the stipulated time period, if not their names will be removed from the rolls.
- ❖ Tuition fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- ❖ If a student wants to leave the college immediately after joining the course, the student should apply for withdrawal duly countersigned by his/her parent/guardian and they cannot claim refund of fees.
- ❖ A student who leaves in the academic year will be issued a Transfer Certificate and shall be required to pay the tuition fee for the remaining period of the programme.
- ❖ The Institution Authorities reserve the right to cancel the admission of a student at any time for unlawful activities without refunding the fees-paid.
- ❖ Students who have obtained admission by giving false information will be summarily dismissed and they have to forfeit the fee paid.

GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT

- ❖ Classes start from 8.30 a.m. Students are advised to come to the college by 8:20 am to attend classes.
- ❖ All students should be dressed in formal attire. Students are advised to adhere to the respective department's dress code. Observance of dress code is compulsory for academic and allied activities in the campus.
- ❖ Boys must come to college with clean shaven faces and neat haircuts. T-shirts, Jeans, sleeveless shirts and other fancy dresses for male-students, T-shirts and jeans, sleeveless tops for the female students are prohibited in the campus.
- ❖ All the female students should wear formal churidars with their shawl pinned in V-shape and male students should wear formal dress with full sleeves or half sleeves, shirt tucked in.

- ❖ An **IDENTITY CARD** is issued to every student. Students have to wear their ID card in the campus, failing which they will be penalized with a fine of Rs. 100/-Loitering, whistling and making noise in the college campus are strictly forbidden.
- ❖ Parking space can be availed by all students who produce License, R.C Book & Insurance to the college office. Helmet is mandatory. Students should park their vehicles only in the space meant for the purpose and must park in an order.
- ❖ Students are not permitted to avail canteen facilities during class hours.
- ❖ Eve teasing and ragging are strictly prohibited. As per Government Order students found guilty of these crimes will be fined up to Rs.25,000/-and rigorous imprisonment will be imposed upto 3 years.
- ❖ Smoking is strictly prohibited not only in the college campus but also outside the college campus
- ❖ Students who are found using drugs or in a drunken state or under the influence of drugs will summarily be dismissed from the college
- ❖ Use of mobile phones in class during class hours is strictly prohibited. Defaulters will be penalized with a fine of Rs. 1000 besides seizure of Mobile.
- ❖ Students are directed to co-operate with the authorities in keeping the college campus clean and tidy. They should avoid writing on walls and throwing scraps of paper in the college premises.
- ❖ Every student should handle the college property with care. Damage caused to college property will be charged to the accounts of the students concerned. If the students, responsible for the damage, could not be identified, the damage caused will be charged to the accounts of all the students.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE

- ❖ Every student is expected to attend
 - a. The College on all working days
 - b. All prescribed hours.
 - c. All the tests and examinations without fail
- ❖ No student shall absent himself/herself without prior information & without any specific reason
- ❖ A medical certificate must be submitted by every student who misses more than three days of class consistently when they return
- ❖ All leave letters must be submitted well in advance, to the Head of the Department through the Tutor In-Charge
- ❖ Attendance will be taken every period.
- ❖ Minimum of 75% attendance is essential to appear for the University Examinations. Students who have attendance between 65% to 74% will be permitted to appear for the University Examination on payment of condonation Fee. Students who have less than 65% of attendance will not be permitted to appear for the regular (present semester) University Examination.
- ❖ The students who secure 100% attendance will be rewarded on the College Day Celebration.

LIBRARY

- ❖ Each student is a member of the Library
- ❖ E-Resource INFLIBNET NLIST is made available for students & teaching staffs.
- ❖ The Library will be kept open between 8.30 a.m. and 5.00p.m on all working days.
- ❖ In case any book is lost or damaged by the member, the member shall replace the book. Any library book lost by the borrowers are replaced by them by new copies. If copies are not available in the market, the current price of the books not returned or double the original price whichever is higher is to be paid by the borrower concerned.
- ❖ Students may approach the Librarian/Tutor-In-Charge/H.O.D/Principal in case of any difficulty in using the facilities of the Library.

TESTS & EXAMINATIONS

- ❖ The college, will conduct two Internal Assessment Exams and a model exam each semester based on University Examination pattern.
- ❖ Attendance is compulsory for all the students in all these examinations.

- ❖ The performance of the students in such tests and examinations will be taken into consideration in taking final decision on allowing the student to the University Examination.
