Online Conference on Climate change

The Institute of Green Engineers (IGEN), an NGO, organizes activities through the VIBBGYOR society, connecting green professionals across the globe, On the 14th and 15th september 2024, they held a 29 hour non-stop event featuring speakers from 29 countries, with 299 speakers discussing themes related to the UN climate change conference and the conservation of the Panchabhutas (the five elements). 873 students from our college participated in this online conference ultimately earning the Gold Award. All the participants were given E-certificate.



Cycle Rally - Conserve Today, Preserve Tomorrow

On 29th August 2024, a cycle rally titled "Conserve Today, Preserve Tomorrow" was held with 40 students covering 3 km. The participants were provided with eco-friendly gear and encouraged to practice sustainability, such as waste reduction and energy conservation. The event was inaugurated by the Principal Mam and featured educational posters along the route, highlighting the importance of protecting natural resources. The rally successfully combined physical activity with environmental awareness, fostering a sense of responsibility among participants.



Nature Conservation

On 26th July 2024, an orientation on environmental protection was held to observe World Nature Conservation Day. Mr. B.S. Arunpandian, HR of Bhumi Foundation, delivered an insightful guest lecture on the importance of protecting the environment. He emphasized the critical need for conservation in light of urbanization, deforestation, pollution, and climate change. Students were inspired to actively contribute to nature conservation, understanding its role in maintaining ecological balance and ensuring resource availability for future generations.



Avoiding Plastic Bags and Using Cloth Bags

On 5th July 2024, an awareness program on avoiding plastic bags was conducted with 80 student participants. The session highlighted the detrimental effects of plastic bags on the environment. Cloth bags were distributed to all participants, and discussions emphasized the importance of replacing plastic with eco-friendly alternatives. The program encouraged students to adopt cloth bags, fostering long-term sustainable practices. By making this simple change, participants were motivated to contribute to a cleaner, greener environment..



Environment Day Celebration

On 05-06-2024, Environment Day was celebrated with the theme "Land Restoration: Building Resilience Against Desertification and Drought." The event aimed to raise awareness about land degradation and its effects on communities and ecosystems. Mr. Natarajan, a social worker from Arogyabharathi, delivered the keynote speech, stressing the need for sustainable land restoration. A tree-planting drive was held, where over 20 native saplings were planted on the college grounds, with active participation from students in the initiative.
