INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY

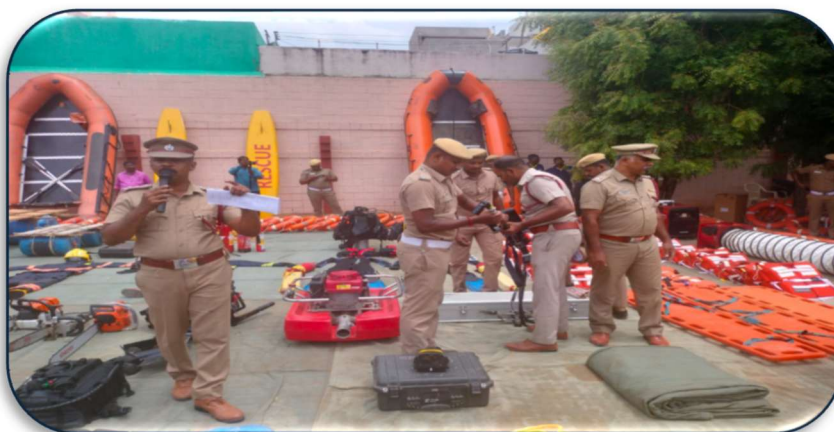
