STUDENTS' DISCIPLINE & DRESS CODE POLICY

- The Classes start from 8.30 a.m., and students are advised to be present in the college by 8:20 am to attend classes. As part of our commitment to maintaining punctuality and discipline, it is mandatory for all students residing in and around the college vicinity to arrive on campus before 8:30 AM.
- Students arriving after 8.45 am will not be allowed to enter the campus and will be sent back home. This decision has been made to ensure smooth functioning and the timely commencement of classes.
- We urge all students to plan their commute accordingly and adhere to this new timing.
- It is the collective responsibility of students to maintain a neat and hygienic environment in our college. A Clean campus reflects discipline and respect for our shared space.
- All students should be dressed in formal attire. Students are advised to adhere to the dress code. Observance of the dress code is compulsory for academic and allied activities on the campus.
- Boys must come to college with clean-shaven faces and neat haircuts. T-shirts, Jeans, sleeveless shirts and other fancy dresses for male students, T-shirts and jeans, sleeveless tops for the female students are prohibited on campus.
- All the female students should wear formal churidars with their shawl, and male students should wear formal dress with full sleeves or half sleeves, with the shirt tucked in.
- Loitering, whistling and making noise in the college campus are strictly forbidden.
- Parking space can be availed by all students who produce a license, R.C Book & Insurance to the college office. A helmet is mandatory. Students should park their vehicles only in the space meant for the purpose and must park in order.
- Students are not permitted to avail canteen facilities during class hours.
- Eve teasing and ragging are strictly prohibited. As per the Government Order, students found guilty of these crimes will be fined up to Rs. 25,000/- and rigorous imprisonment will be imposed up to 3 years.

- Smoking is strictly prohibited in and around the college campus.
- Students who are found using drugs or in a drunken state will summarily be dismissed from the college.
- Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited. Defaulters will be penalised with a fine of Rs.1000/- besides seizure of the mobile.
- Students are directed to cooperate with the authorities in keeping the college campus clean and tidy. They should avoid writing on walls and throwing scraps of paper in the college premises.
- Every student should handle the college property with care. Damage caused to college property will be charged to the accounts of the students concerned.
- Students should park their vehicles only in the parking area. If any vehicle is found outside, the fine amount of Rs.1,000/- will be collected from the concerned student.
- During College events Students are expected to maintain discipline and decorum throughout the function. TC will be issued to the students who are involved in fights in and outside the campus. Any damage caused to the college property, a fine of Rs. 10,000/- will be collected from the student.
- The disciplinary issues, such as shooting or clicking pictures without permission or getting involved in fights using vulgar or unparliamentary words, damaging college property, using drugs in any forms will be handled by the disciplinary committee and its decision will be final. Such unwanted action will invite a fine of Rs.2,500/- besides disciplinary actions as per Government regulations.
