



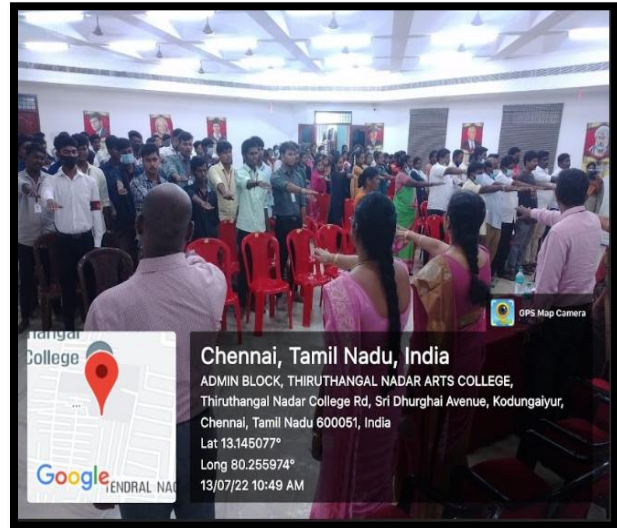
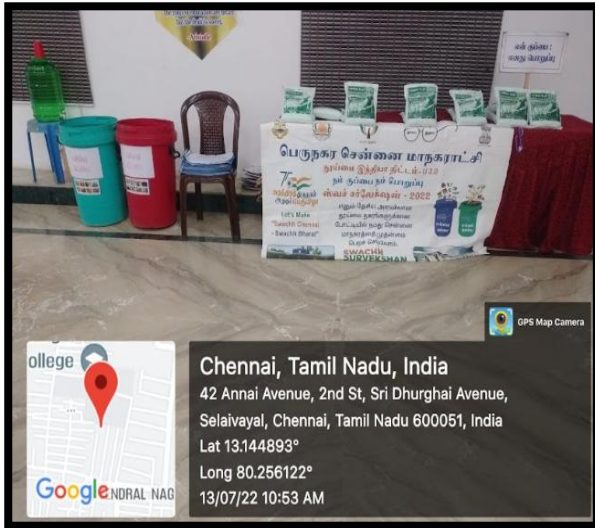
**Title: "Solid waste management and Eco friendly environment"**

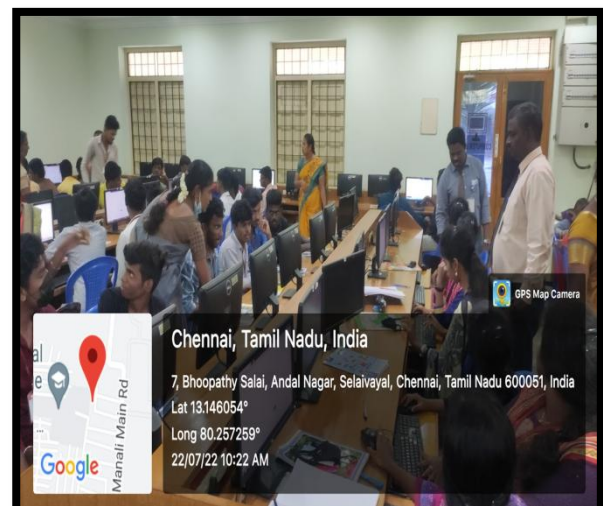




**Title: "Data Science Using Python"**

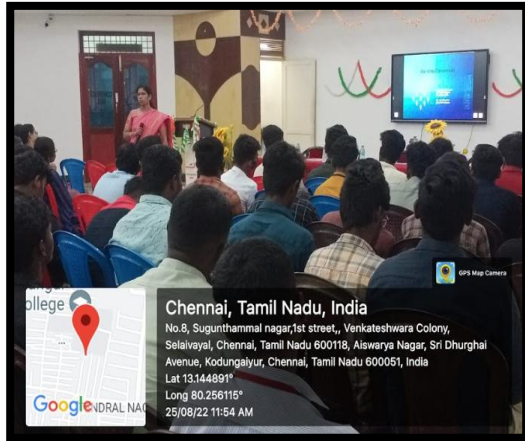
**Title: “Real World Applications of Block Chain”**

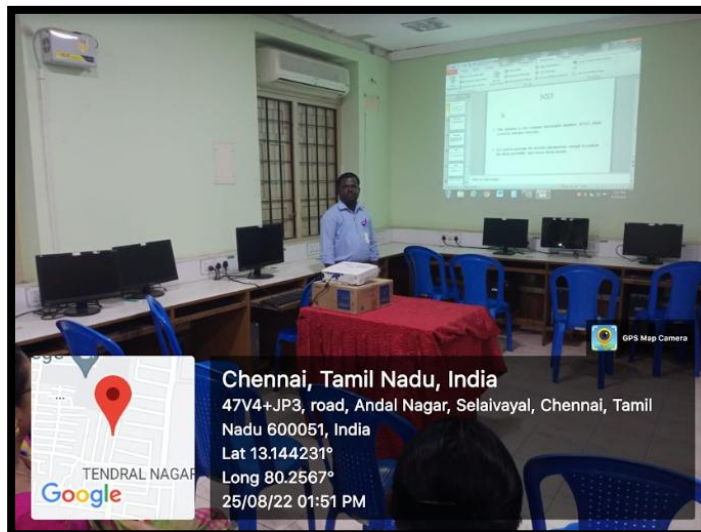

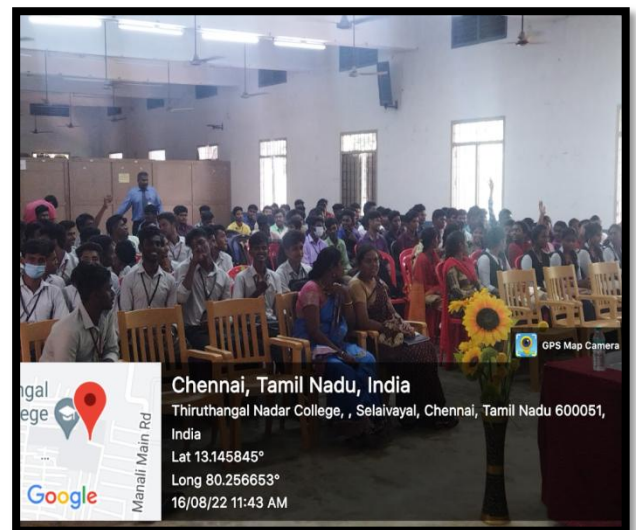

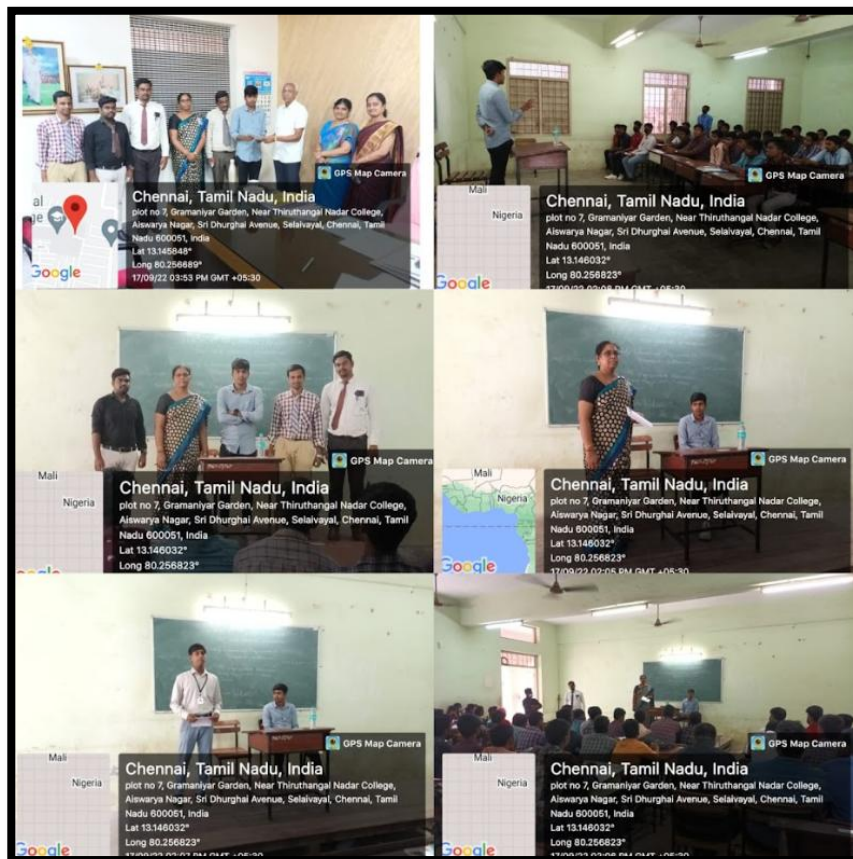
**Title: "Technology in Banking"**

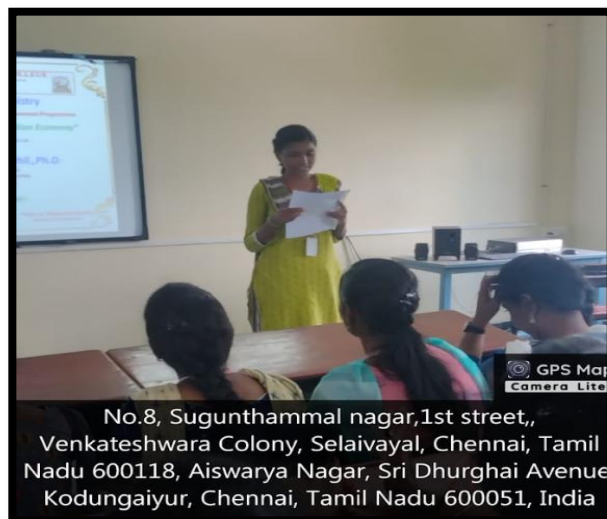
**Title: "Role of Chemical Industries in Indian Economy"**

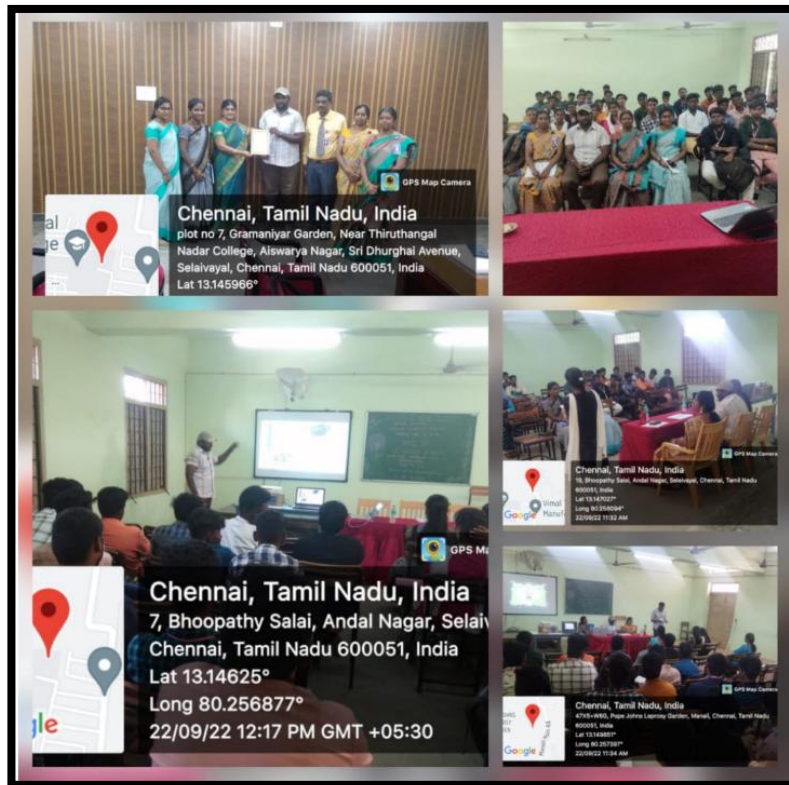
**Title: "App Development in Kotlin"**

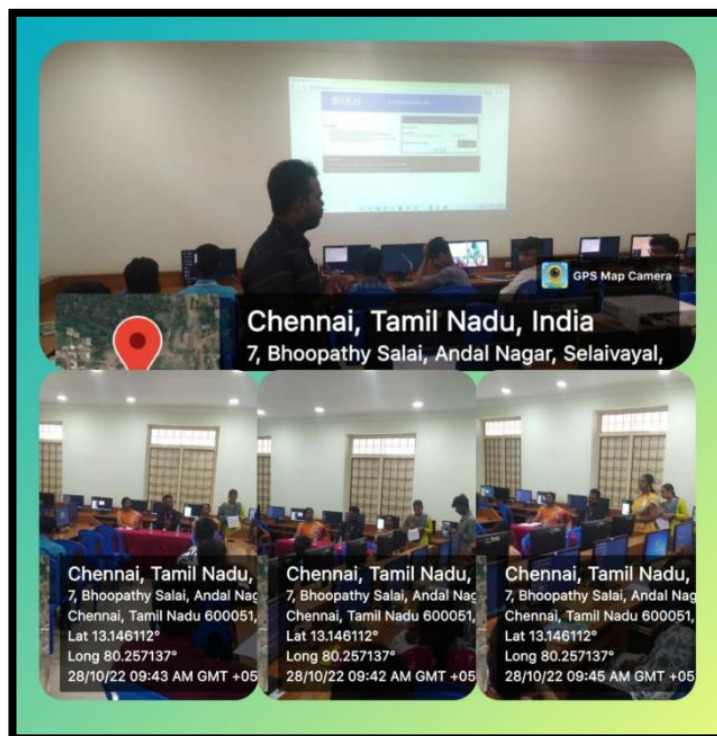

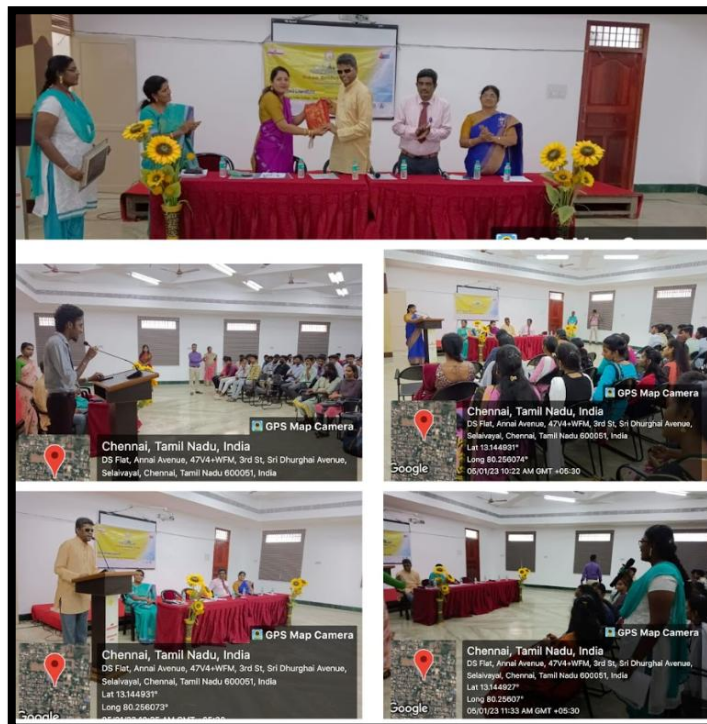
**Title: "Marginalised Literature"**

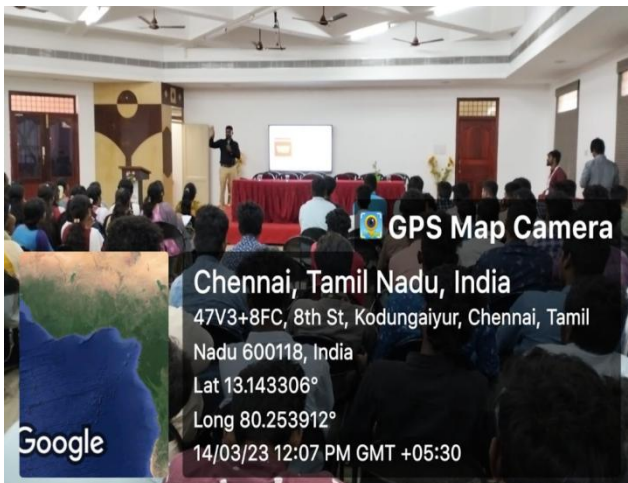
**Title: “Full Stack Software Development”**
