The IQAC conducted the External Audit on 04-06-2022 for the Academic Year 2020-2021. The five Quality Audit members involved in this Audit,





- Program outcome (PO)
- Course outcome (CO)
- Knowledge (K)

Program outcome is the degree outcome which is to be formed with certain points of about 5 (or) 10.

Syllabus of the course (subject) in units.


- I Unit CO1
- II Unit CO2......and all the five, from which unit we take the questions are represented in the form of COs. Next is knowledge based (i.e.) knowledge represented as K1, K2, K3, K4..... Each K's has separate and unique concepts,

categories & options like understanding, thinking, conceptual, etc.,

The next part is about attainment. It represents the result in the point scale. The weight age and how the syllabus has an effect on the Program Outcome Course Outcome. On the basis of a Comparison of program outcome and course outcome. The points are tabulated and the average on all these are been calculated then the various steps were presented and the final result of attainment is found.

She explained in very clear and depth each step in the form of Excel sheets which made us the guidance on preparation of question papers in Bloom's taxonomy Model.




