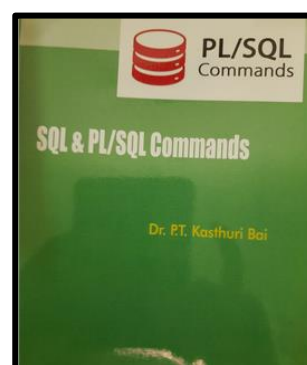
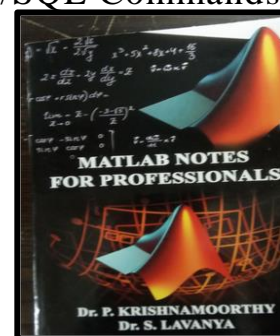
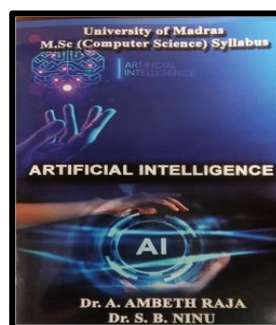

from various Science stream departments participated.



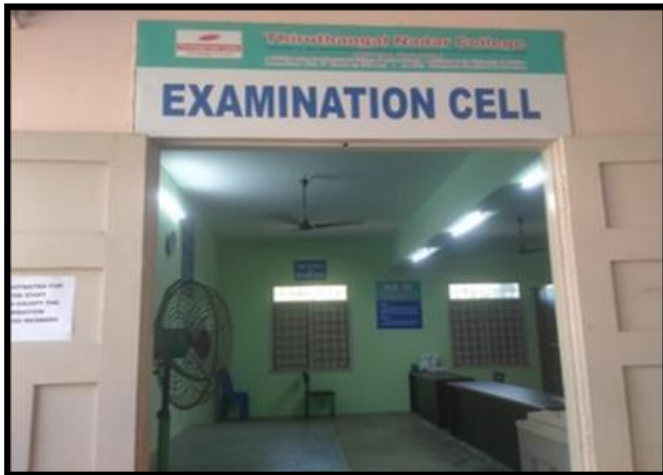
EXAMINATION CELL

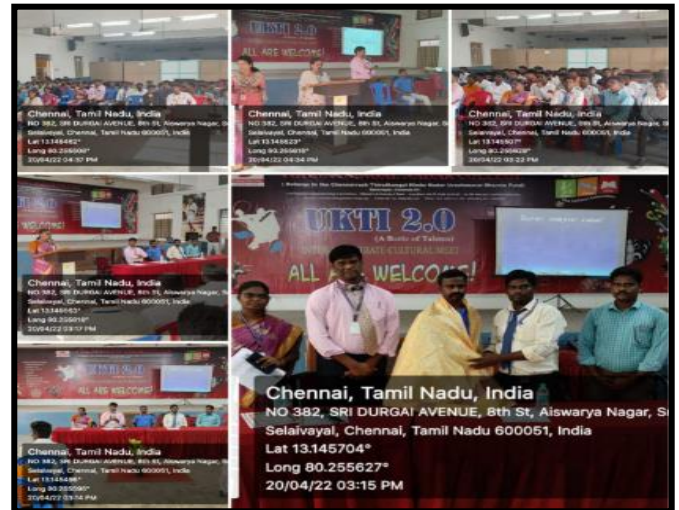
B.COM COMPUTER APPLICATIONS

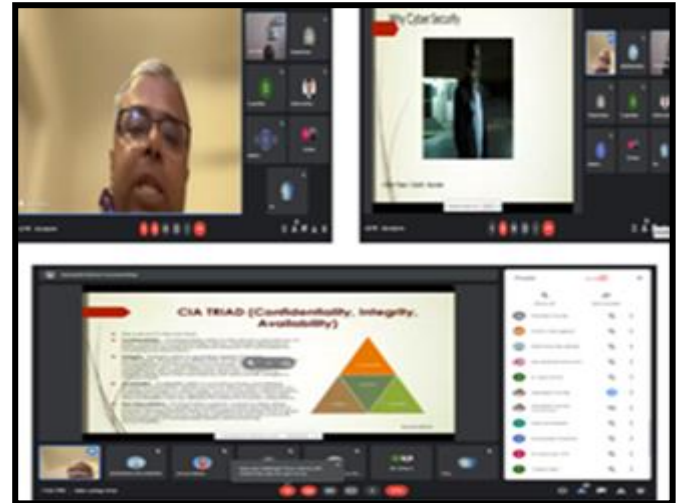


PG DEPARTMENT OF COMPUTER SCIENCE

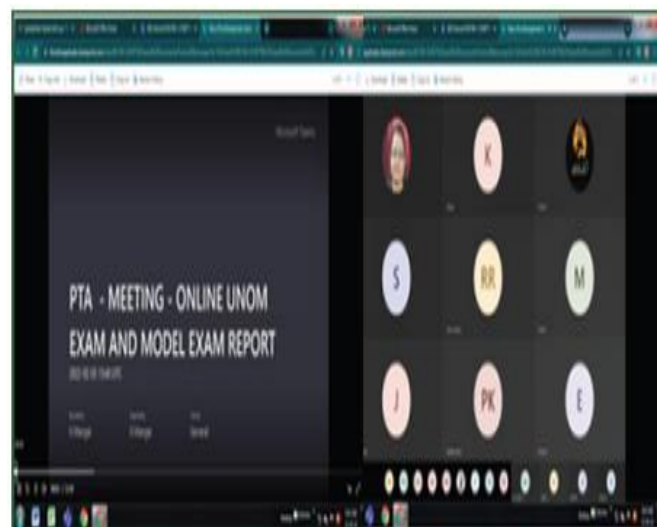
LIBRARY

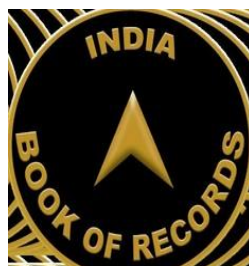
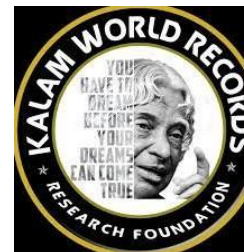

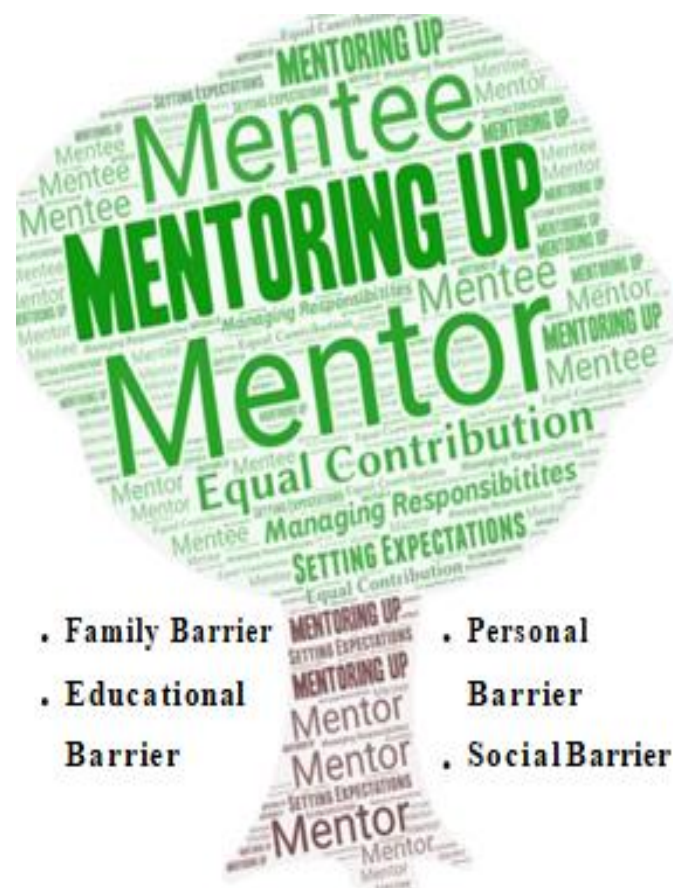
