NAAC VISIT

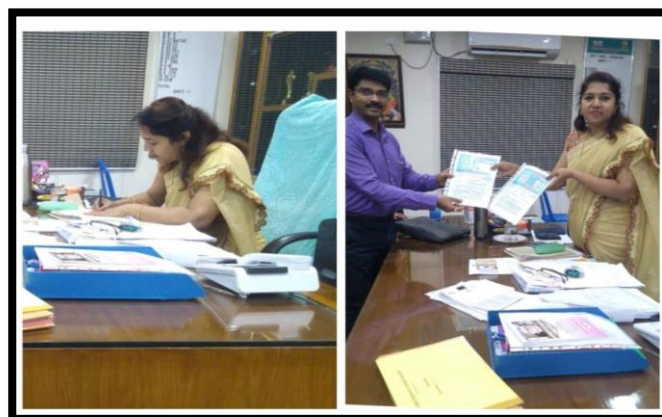
The NAAC Peer Team Visited the College for II Cycle Assessment on 10th and 11th January 2023.

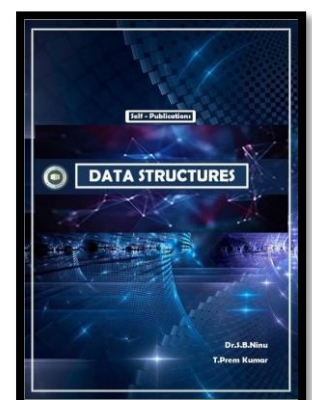
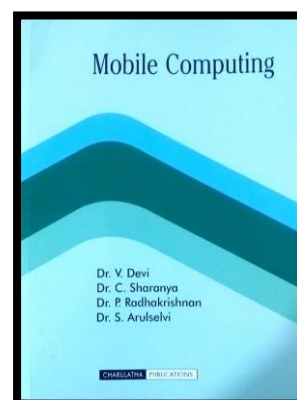

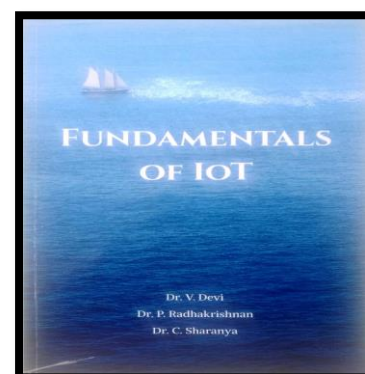

CERTIFICATE COURSES/ADD ON COURSES

- ✚ Digital Marketing and E-Banking (ACSOC301) comprehensive 30hrs certificate course was introduced to equip participants with a deep understanding of digital marketing strategies, tools and techniques. Nearly 526 students completed and received certificates.
- ✚ Logistics Management (ACSOC201), a certificate course was introduced for the 2nd year Commerce Stream students to impart knowledge on Logistics Management and its roles, types, warehouse types and equipment and Foreign Trade Policy. 483 wards completed the course successfully and got certified.
- ✚ GNU Image Manipulation Program (ACSCS201), a certificate course was implemented to provide knowledge on OS-Installation (Window & Linux, Dual OS Installation, Processor (ZIF, Type, SEC, etc.), External Drives, Networking devices, media, layers, and IP Addresses (Version, Classes, Types).

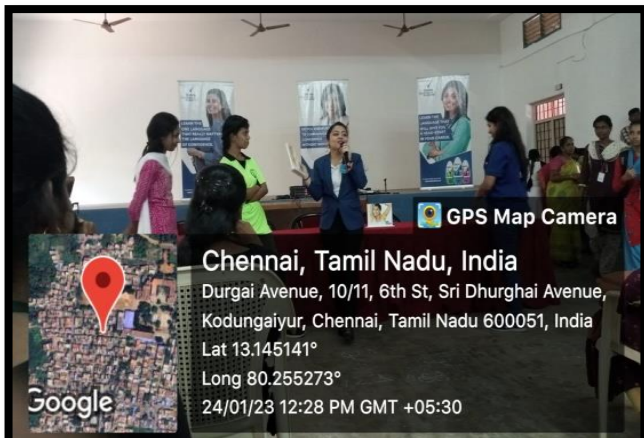

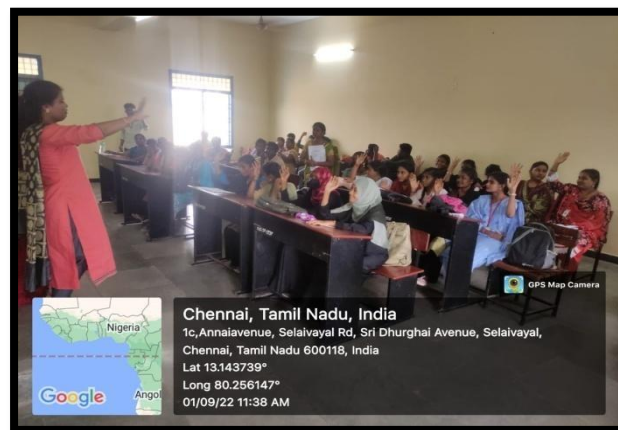
thoughtful communication through the creative arts.

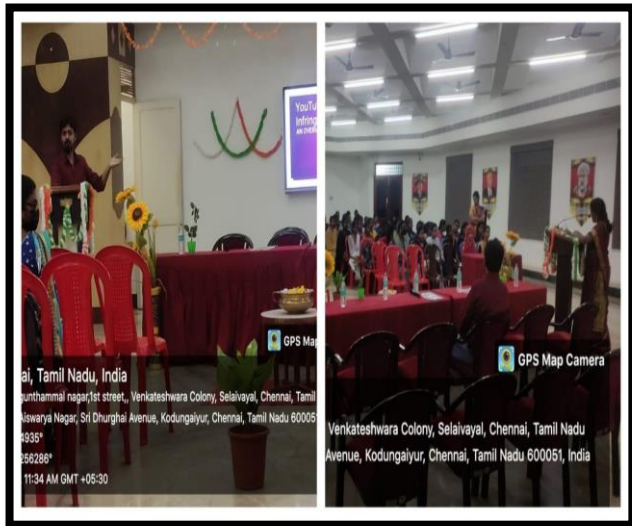

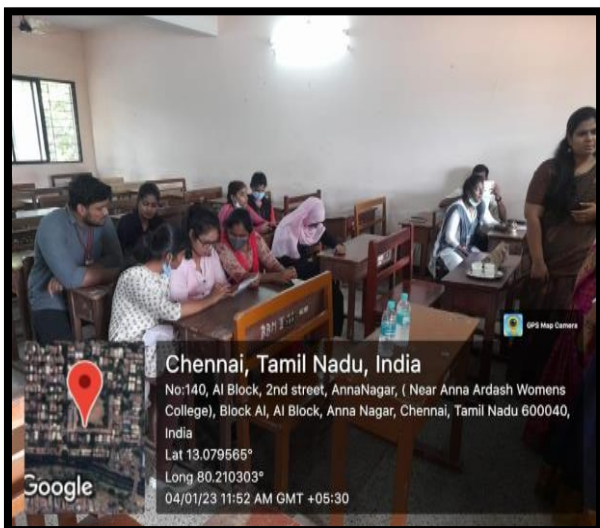


FIELD TRIP
