

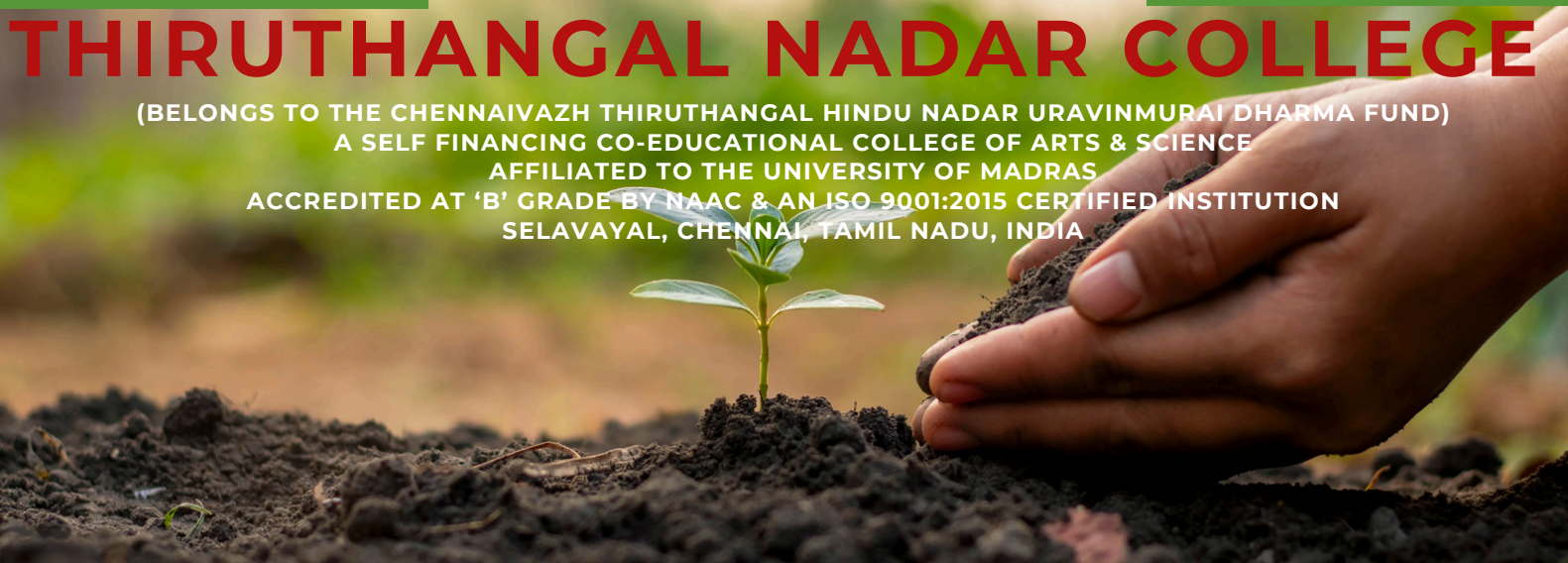

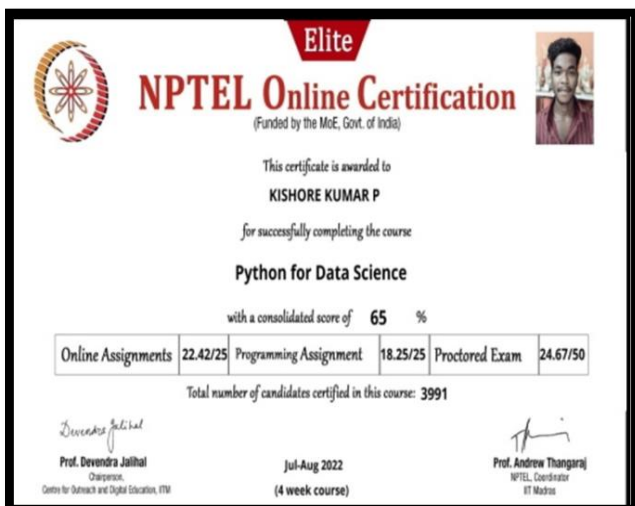




The Department of Social Work, in collaboration with FEMA, had organised the 5 Days Certificate course on Counselling Psychology from 17th October to 21st October 2022.

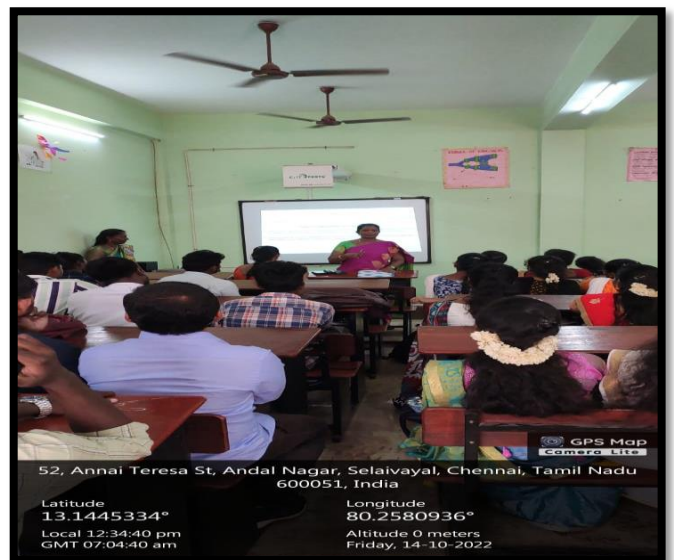

Professor, Department of Bcom(ISM) bestowed her presentation on the topic “Routing Anomaly Detection in MANET”.

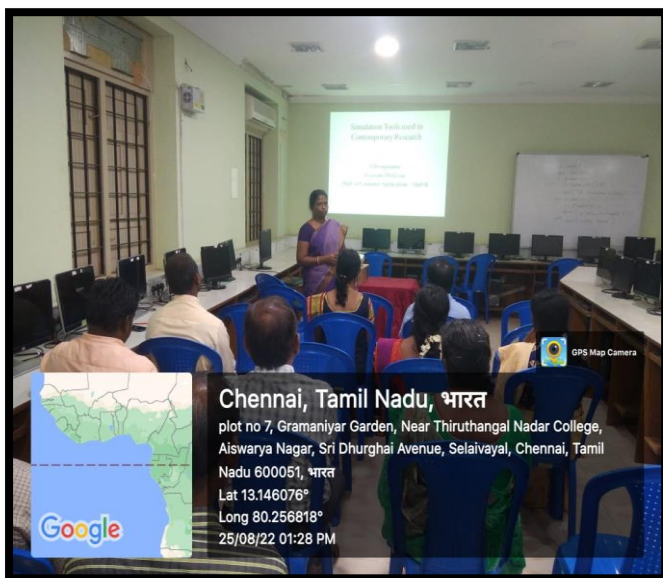

### INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY

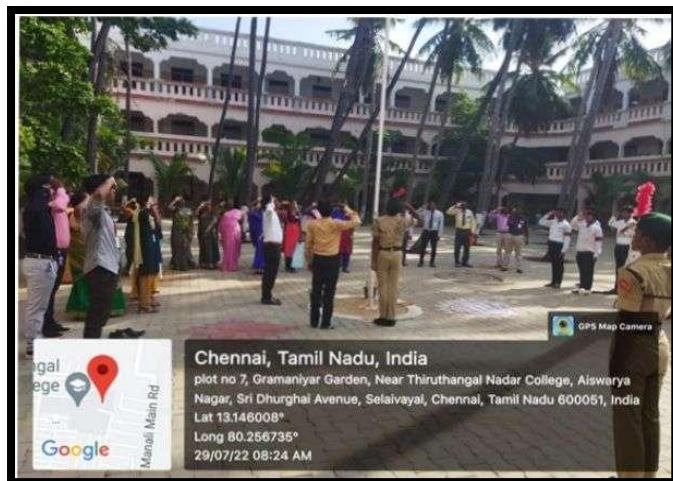

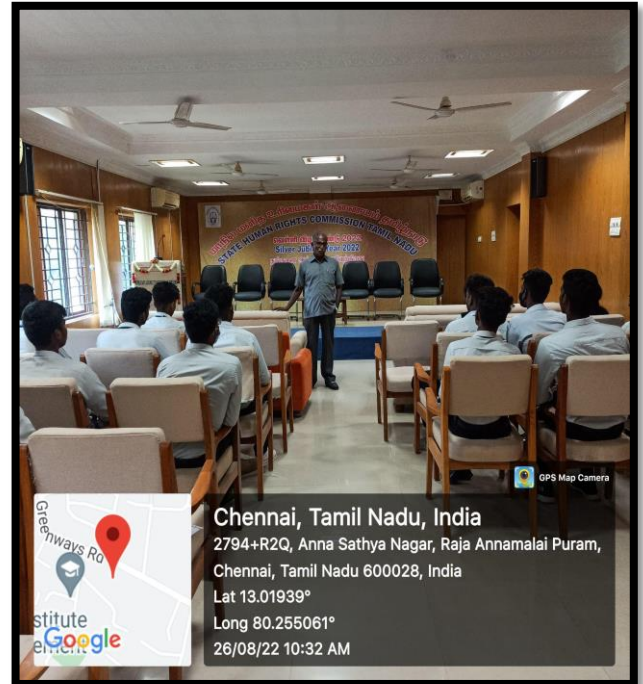

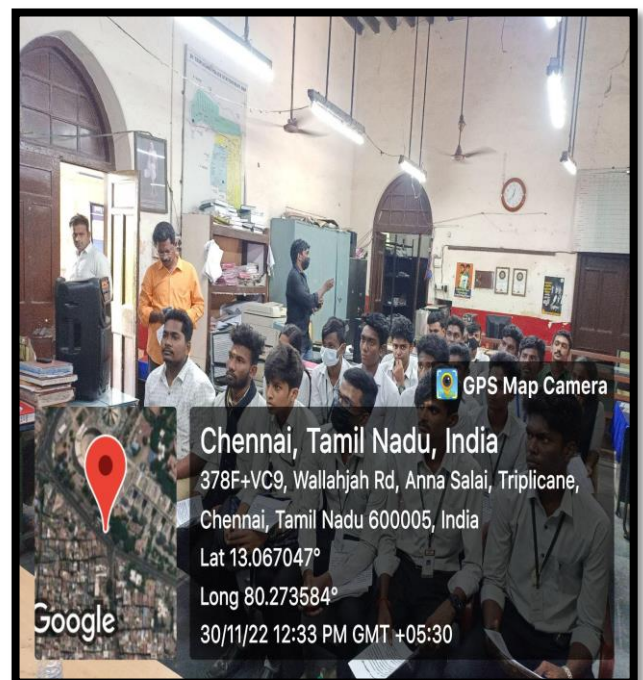


Students visited the State Human Rights

## POSTER MAKING COMPETITION - 75TH INDEPENDENCE DAY

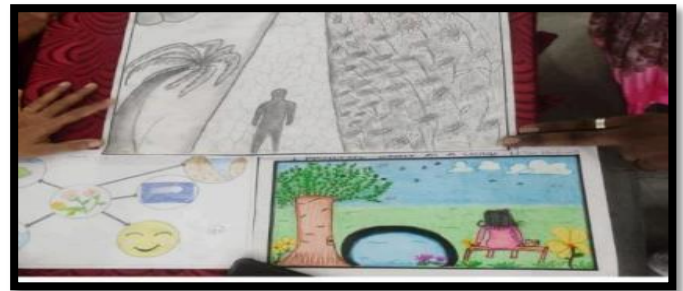
