Applicants for the Degree Courses should have passed the Higher Secondary Examination (Standard XII under the 10+2 pattern prevalent in Tamil Nadu or its equalent to other boards)

Candidates who pass the All India Senior School Certificate Examinations, New Delhi, will be eligible for admission provided they pass the examination with a minimum of five subjects of which English shall be compulsory. An applicant should produce an "Eligibility Certificate", from the University of Madras, at the time of interview.

Foreign students should provide a regular, long term student Visa issued by respective Indian Embassy.

Applicants for the PG Courses should have obtained an undergraduate degree in the concerned subject or as per the eligibility required for the course.

- Fees has to be paid on admission into the Course.
- If the fees is not paid within the stipulated time the candidate will forfeit the seat. The seat will be allocated to the candidate who is next in the list.
