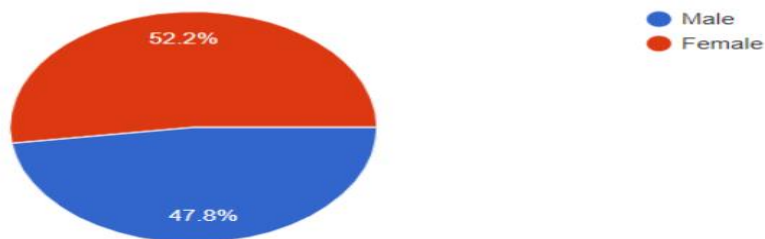
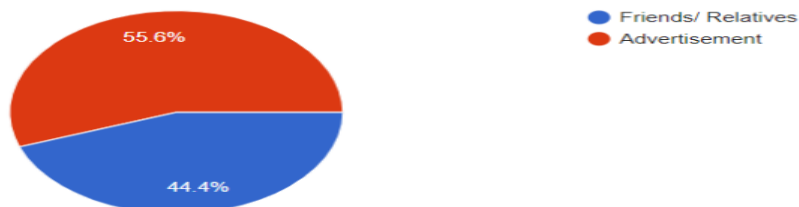


CHART - 2
