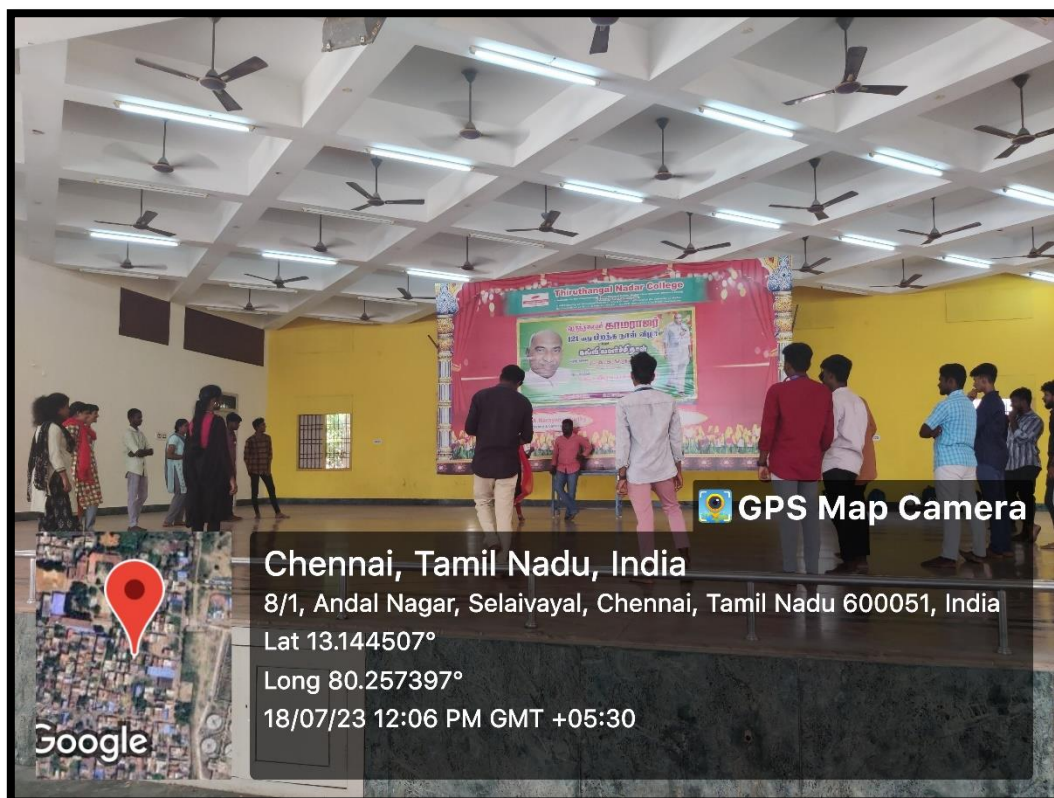
Event Name: Street Theatre Training

Event Name: Life skills programme on Silent Reading Revolution

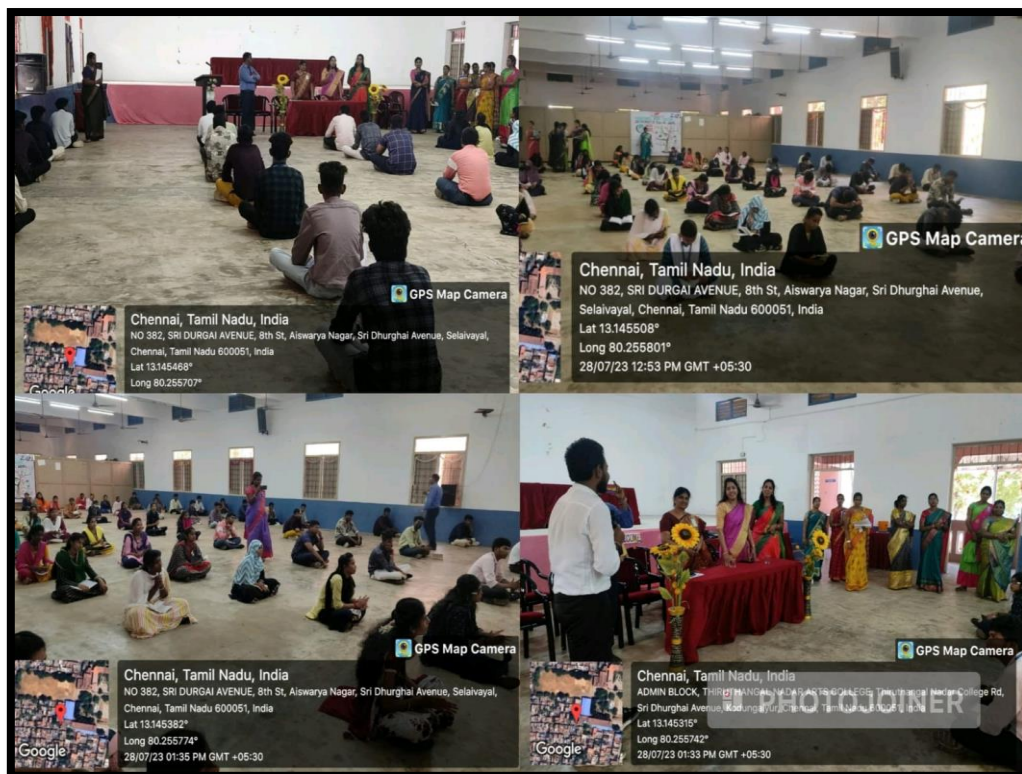
