Title: International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking

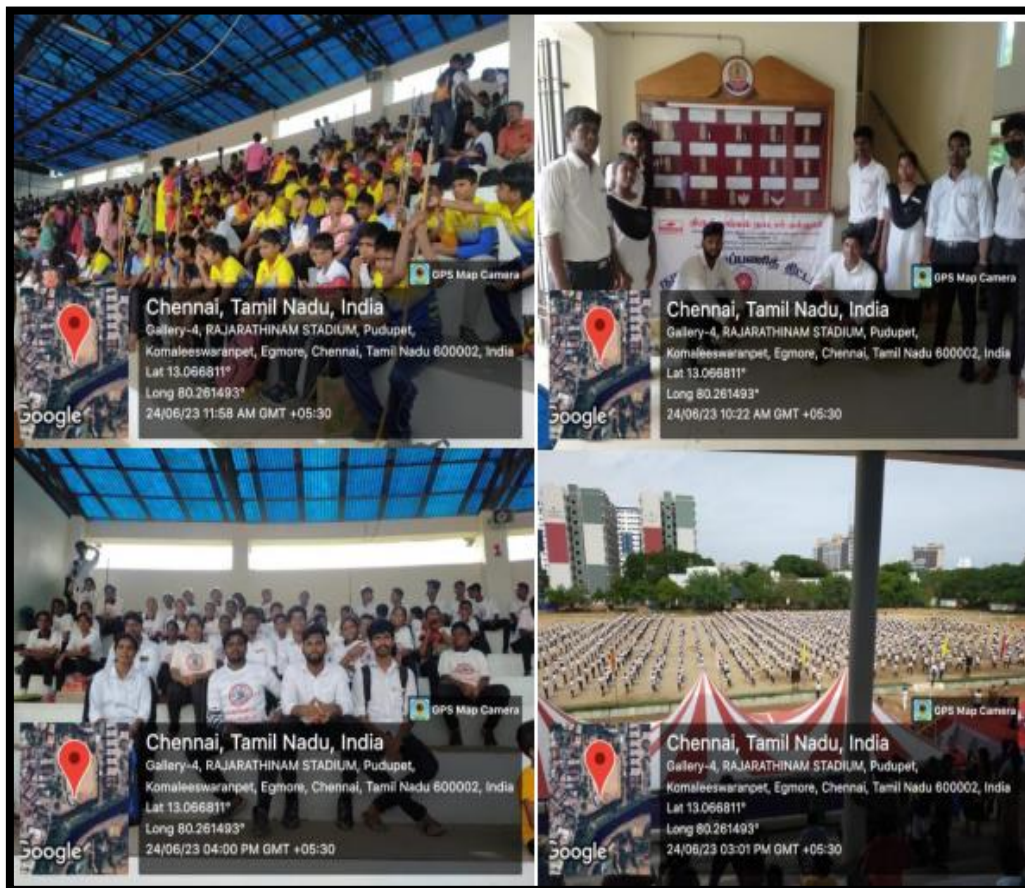

Title: "Skill Development Programme on Mobile Phone"

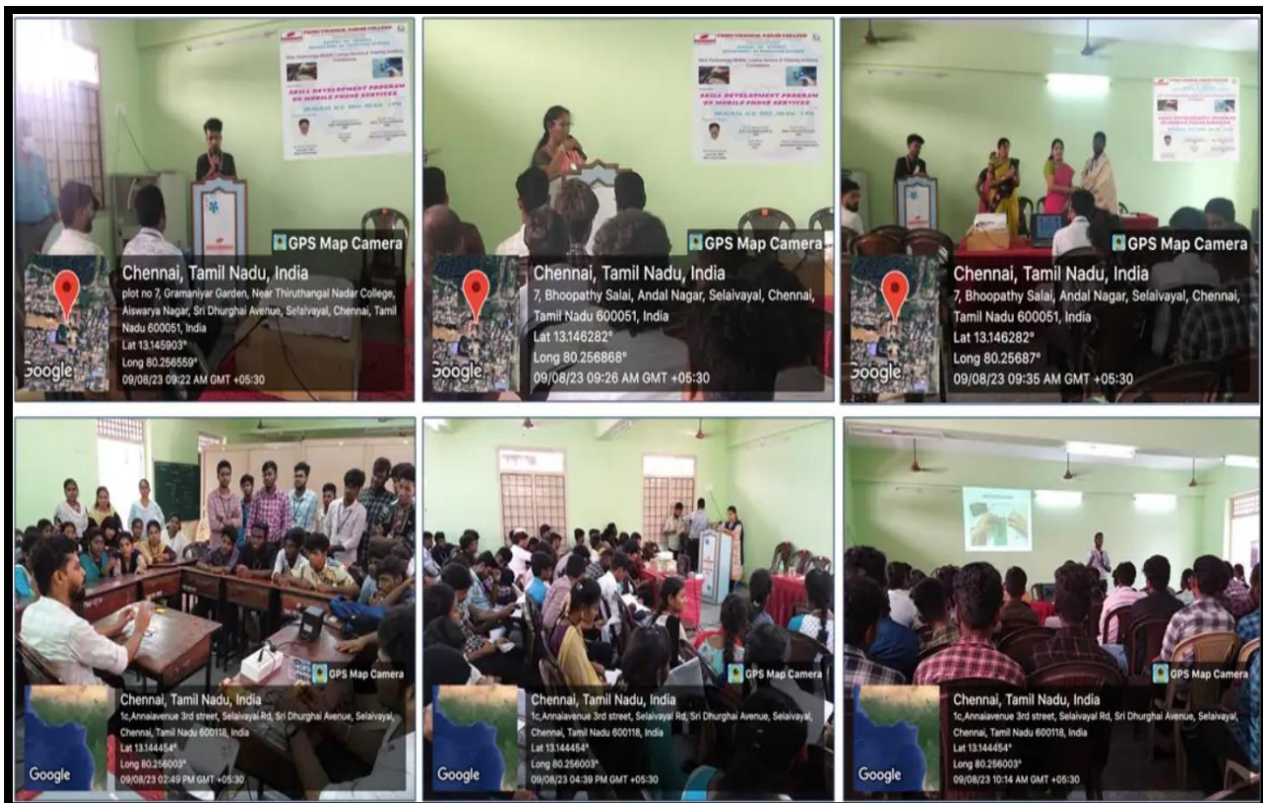

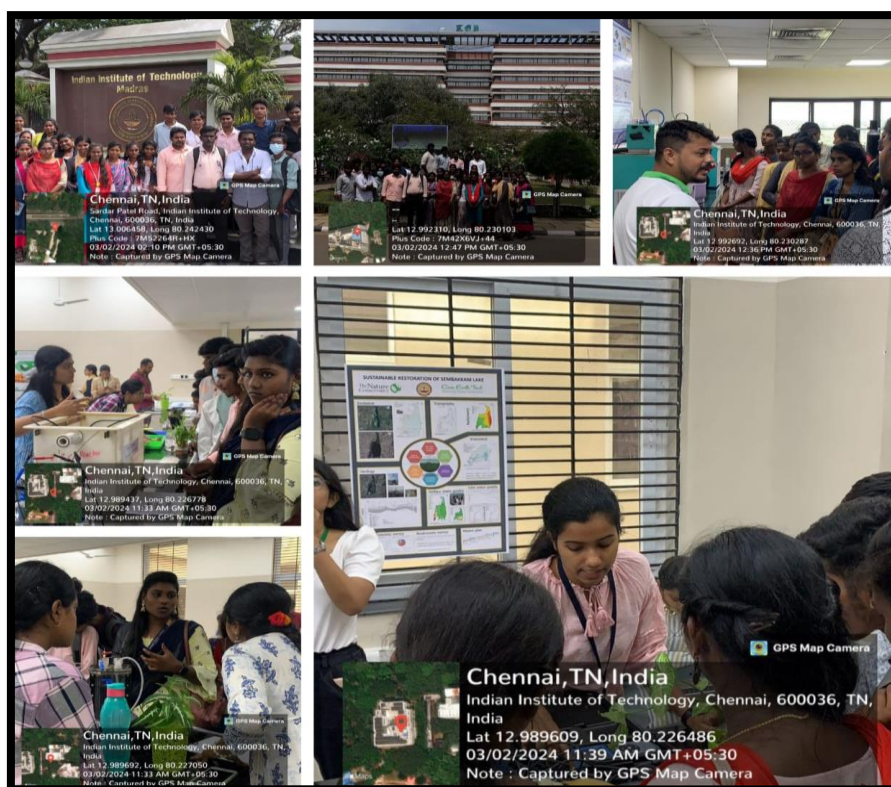
Educational Visit to IIT Madras
