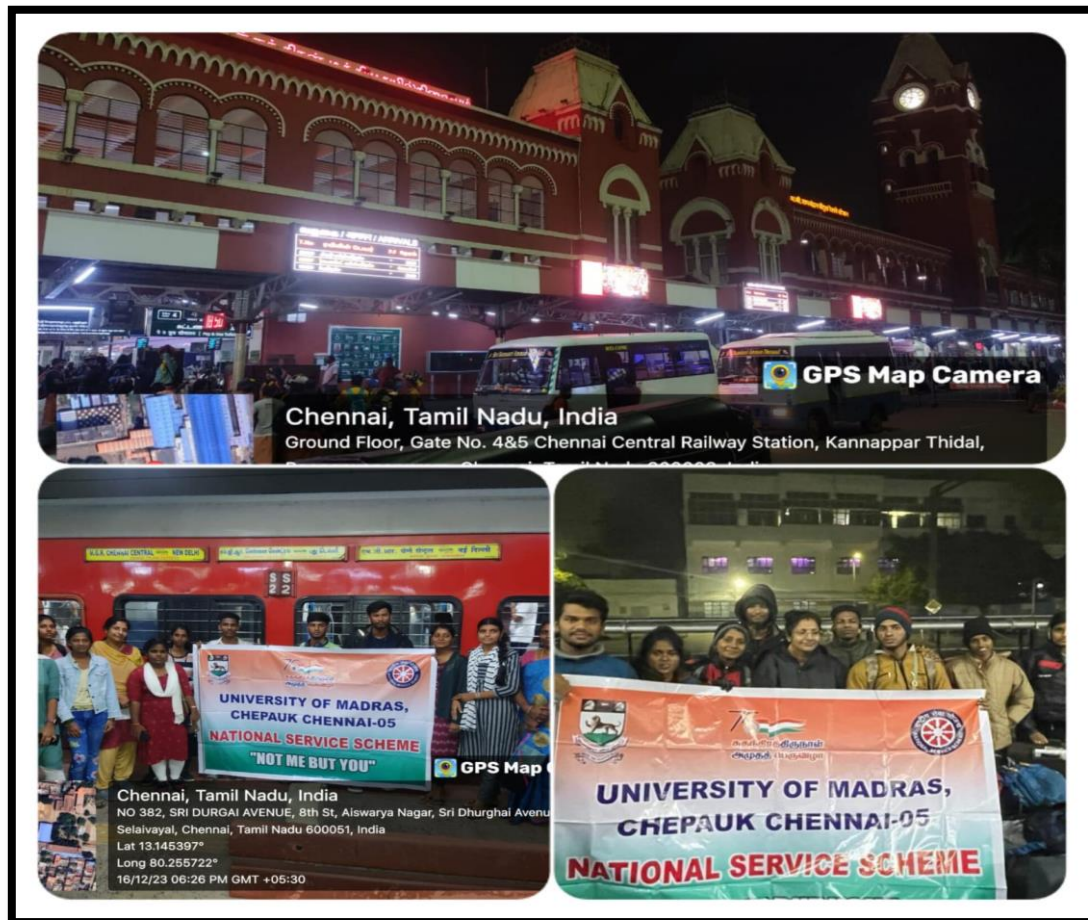

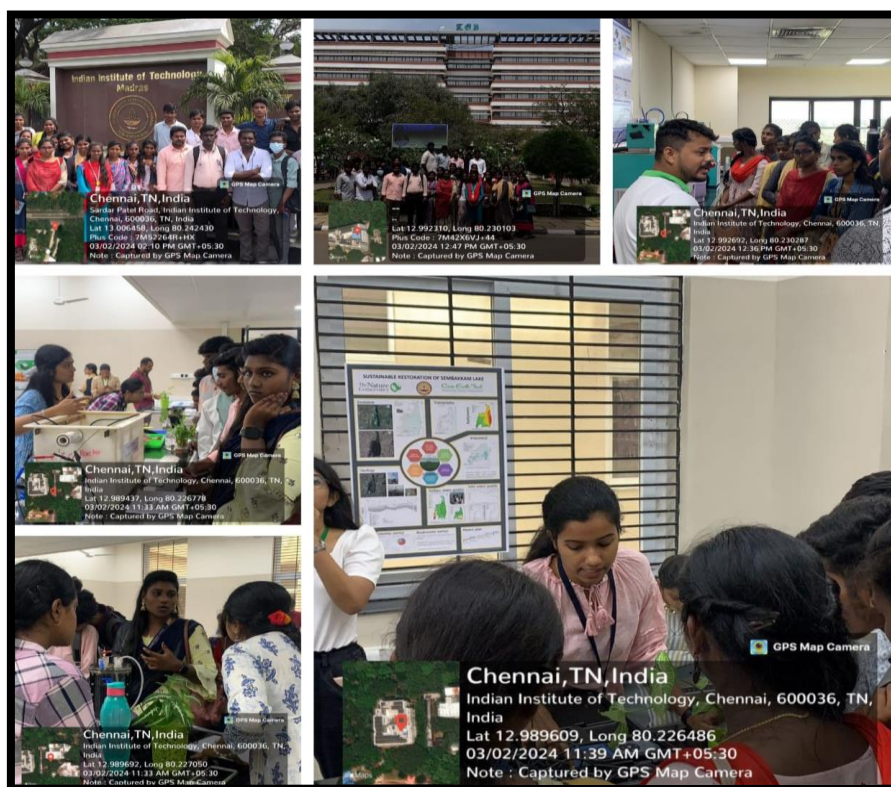
Educational Visit to IIT Madras
