Each Party acknowledges and agrees that any and all information emanating from the other Party's business, in any form, including but not limited to information relating to the disclosing party's past, present, or future research, development or business activities is "Confidential and

2. Processing of Personal Data:

- i. - v. For the purposes of this DPA, "Applicable Privacy Laws" means all laws, codes, statutes, rules and regulations with which each Party is legally obliged to comply during the term of
