REACHING OUT TO THE COMMUNITY

TITLE OF THE PRACTICE

AWARENESS PROGRAMME TO THE FARMERS ON SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE

OBJECTIVES

- Identification of suitable land or space for organic farming activities, considering factors such as soil quality, sunlight exposure, and water availability.
- Procurement of organic seeds, fertilizers, and other necessary materials for cultivation.
- Training sessions conducted for NSS volunteers to familiarize them with organic farming techniques, including soil preparation, composting and natural pest management, and crop rotation.

THE CONTEXT:

Agriculture is both a beneficiary and provider of biodiversity and related ecosystem services. Diverse, healthy agricultural landscapes provide habitat to flora and fauna, purify air and water, and provide climate change mitigation and carbon sequestration. In turn, agriculture benefits from soil erosion control, important services from wildlife such as pollination and pest management, and a source of genetic diversity for plants and livestock, as well as food, fuel, fibre, water, and medicinal resources.

THE PRACTICE:

- Organic farming provides students with practical, hands-on experience in agriculture, sustainability, and environmental stewardship.
- Students can engage in cross-disciplinary learning by integrating concepts from fields such as biology, environmental science, nutrition, and business management.
- It promotes awareness of environmental issues and the importance of sustainable agricultural practices in mitigating climate change, protecting biodiversity, and conserving natural resources.

EVIDENCE OF SUCCESS:

On the 28th of February 2024, Department of Plant Biology and Plant Biotechnology in association with NSS Volunteers of TNC, organized awareness programme to the farmers on Sustainable agriculture at **Thirunillai Village, Choolavaram Panchayat Union, Tiruvallur District.** Many students and people from were participated.

PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED:

By implementing sustainable agriculture as a best practice at Thiruthangal Nadar college in collaboration with the NSS Program, we aim to create a model for rational campus agriculture that fosters environmental Governance, enhances student learning experiences, and strengthens community partnerships. Participants with elevated sugar levels (above 80-120) were advised to consult a doctor for further evaluation.

The event was supported by I BSW students and 10 NSS volunteers, who rendered their services to ensure the camp's success.


